Realization

From september 18th to 21st 2023, we will set up the mobile RadioChico Studio in the «Berner Generationenhaus» near Berne central station and broadcast LIVE from the capital city. An important part of this World Peace Week is to show how **«solidarity»** can look like. Showing and also demonstrating how, to what extent and why everyone is special as an individual and why exactly these unique features can serve and help everyone is an essential goal of the project. In addition, we plan to not simply depict, but to set examples wherever applicable.

The studio will be open to the public daily during broadcast hours. The interviews can be followed on site. You can also deliver you own statement in front of the microphone and provide your view of how **«solidarity»** can succeed.

In order to make the radio experience as interesting as possible for everyone, live interviews on the topic of solidarity take place every half hour and every hour throughout the week. All interviews are posted on RadioChico's website as podcasts and can be listened to at any time.
